

# JUSTICE COURT LAS VEGAS TOWNSHIP MODERATE OFFENDER PROGRAM STATISTICAL REPORT

The following statistics reflect the Moderate Offender Program's operation since its inception on April 21, 2003.

- 143 Candidates have been referred to program to date
- 19 Have opted out of the program before screening evaluation conducted
- 13 Have opted out after screening evaluation conducted but before starting program
- 8 Have been discharged from the program
  - one was deported
  - six for program violations
  - one committed suicide
- 1 Is awaiting to be evaluated for the program
- 6 Are awaiting to start post-screening
- 26 Have successfully completed the program to date
- 61 Are currently enrolled in the program and are active participants
  - 60 - in intensive outpatient treatment
  - 1 - awaiting to go into in-patient program

## Demographics of active participants

- 55 males [90%]
- 6 females [10%]
- 28 Caucasian [46%]
- 22 Hispanic [36%]
- 2 Asian [3%]
- 6 African American [10%]
- 3 Native American [5%]

Other program facts (based on 143 listed program referrals & 61 active participants – there are 14 referrals which no data was collected as they never presented for evaluation)

- 19 Currently on house arrest [31% of active participants]
- 5 1<sup>st</sup> DUI - 1 hit&run leaving the scene, 2 high BACs [4%]
- 48 1 previous DUI arrest [34%]
- 41 2 previous DUI arrests [29%]
- 15 3 previous DUI arrests [10%]
- 6 4 previous DUI arrests [4%]
- 4 6 previous DUI arrests [3%]
- 2 7 previous DUI arrest [2%]
- 1 9 previous DUI arrests [1%]
- 2 11 previous DUI arrests [2%]
- 14 DUI arrest record undetermined [10%]  
(These were the ones who opted out prior to evaluation)
- 87 Diagnosed with alcohol dependence [61%]
- 2 Diagnosed with cannabis dependence [2%]
- 31 Diagnosed with alcohol abuse [22%]
- 2 Diagnosed with cocaine dependence [2%]
- 1 Diagnosed with amphetamine dependence [1%]
- 4 Failed program due to alcohol use [3%]
- 11 Returned to custody for program violations [13%]  
(one participant was returned to custody 3 times)
- 1 Program participants have re-offended (committed another DUI) [1%]
- 26 Program graduates to date [18%]
- 15 Relapse episodes [10%]
  - 4 failed the program [3%]
  - 10 were continued in the program with an increase in their level of care [11%]

- 1 is pending removal from program [1%]
