

DUI COURT PROGRAM STATISTICS

These statistics reflect the historical account of the DUI court program. It includes its origin as the *Moderate Offender Program*, launched on April 21, 2003 and restructured into the *DUI Court Program* in February 2006. On April 13, 2006, the DUI Court Program officially kicked off its first dedicated calendar under the direction of Judge Tony Abbatangelo in Justice Court, Las Vegas Township Dept. 3. The following statistics are as of January 31, 2007.
