**Drug courts integrate alcohol and other drug treatment services with justice system case processing.**

# Component #2

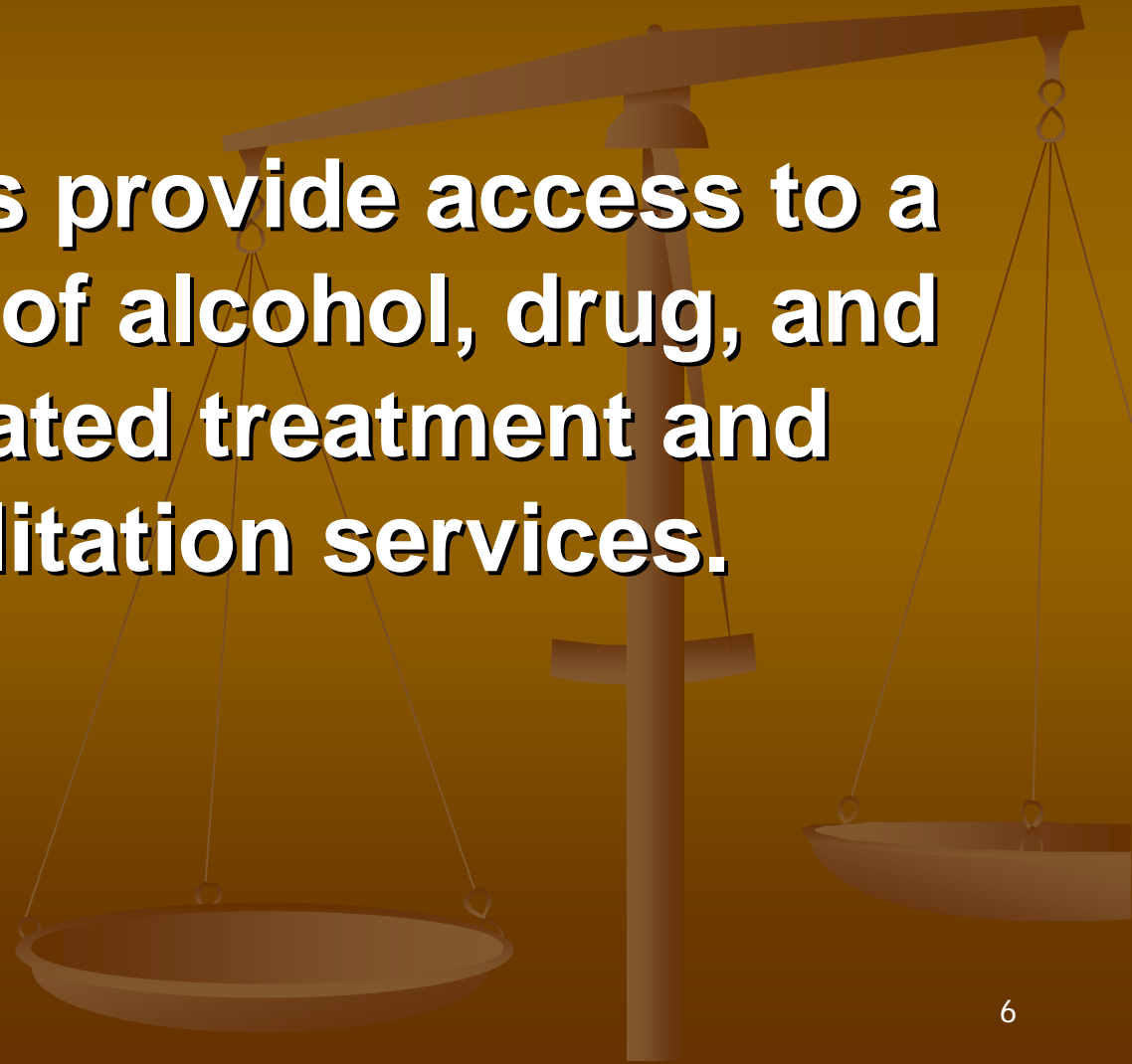
**Using a non-adversarial approach, prosecution and defense counsel promote public safety while protecting participants' due process rights.**

# Component #3

**Eligible participants are identified early and promptly placed in a drug court program.**

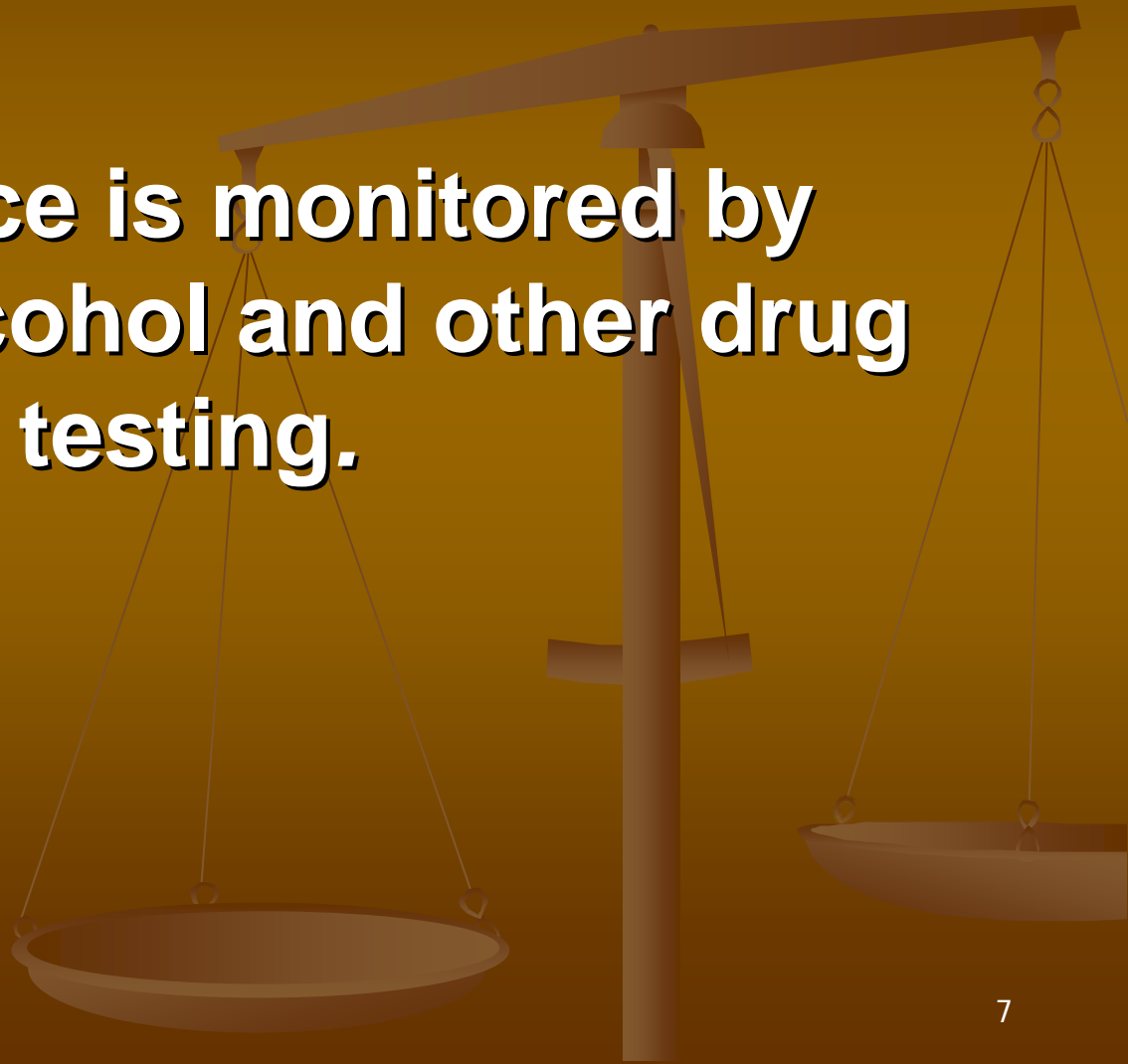
# Component #4

**Drug courts provide access to a continuum of alcohol, drug, and other related treatment and rehabilitation services.**



# Component #5

**Abstinence is monitored by frequent alcohol and other drug testing.**



# Component #6

**A coordinated strategy governs drug court responses to participants' compliance.**



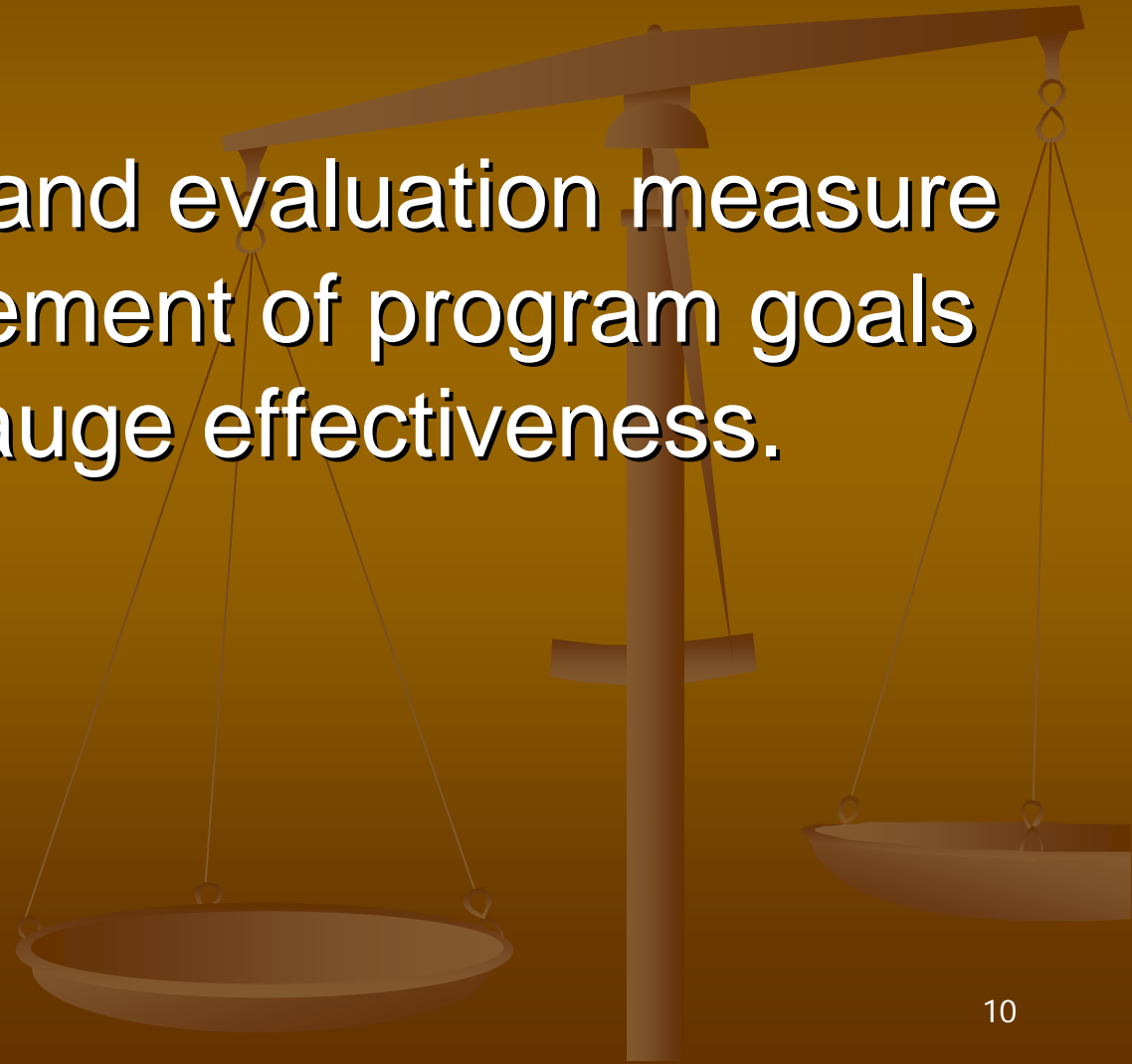
# Component #7

**Ongoing judicial interaction with each drug court participant is essential.**



# Component #8

Monitoring and evaluation measure the achievement of program goals and gauge effectiveness.

**Continuing interdisciplinary education promotes effective drug court planning, implementation, and operations.**
